

Breastfeeding Resource Center awarded grant

The BRC was awarded a \$5,000 grant from the GreenTree Community Health Foundation

Abington, Pa. May 24, 2019 -- Showing their support and belief in the work that the non-profit Breastfeeding Resource Center does in the community, the Green Tree Foundation awarded the center with \$5,000 toward operating expenses.

The BRC provides expert lactation consultations for all clients- no matter their financial situation or level of insurance coverage. Offering a sliding scale payment program, the local non-profit serves families and babies in the greater Philadelphia area with access to International Board Certified Lactation Consultants and a network of Community Counselors.

The mission of the Green Tree Community Health Foundation is to improve the health status of community residents by initiating and supporting activities in response to identified needs in partnership with community resources.

"This will help us continue to offer support to families in the area – no matter what," said Executive Director Colette Acker, IBCLC. "We are so grateful that the community continues to support the important work that we do here."

The breastfeeding support center also offers several free support groups, and workshops and classes are held at both the King of Prussia and Abington locations.

When breastfeeding is not as easy as new families expect, the BRC is there for them with consultations, support groups, back to work and pumping consultations.
